



College Relations Committee

Purpose & Responsibilities

The SHRM-GT College Relations Chair is appointed by the SHRM-GT President and serves as a voting member of the SHRM-GT Board of Directors. The College Relations Chair will, with the assistance of the SHRM-GT Board of Directors, select a Co-Chair and committee members.

The College Relations Committee is charged with responsibility to assist and promote student activities within the Tucson metropolitan area in a manner that promotes the HR profession.

The College Relations Committee works closely with the local schools and colleges in coordinating and carrying out these responsibilities. The College Relations Committee promotes SHRM-GT goals by supporting faculty advisors and students to include membership in SHRM, SHRM-GT, and professional development. The SHRM-GT College Relations Committee:

1. Serves as a liaison between student chapters/members and SHRM-GT.
2. Promotes the formation of new student chapters within the area by identifying potential schools and colleges and working with their faculty and staff to develop these sites.
3. Serves as a communications link between student chapters/members and SHRM-GT in disseminating information relative to student programs, scholarships, certification, student conferences, etc.
4. Encourages participation of student chapters/members in the SHRM Student Case Competition & Career Summit on local, state and national levels.
5. Promotes student activities at professional conferences within the state, region and at the SHRM Annual Conference and Exposition.
6. Collaborates with student chapters, faculty advisors and SHRM-GT Board of Directors, its committees, and the AZ-SHRM College Relations Committee to encourage student participation in local professional chapter meetings.
7. Encourages SHRM-GT members and local employers to offer assistance to student chapters/members through scholarship programs, internships, special student activities, or sponsorship at local, state, or national conferences.
8. Develops recognition programs for chapter advisors/faculty including, but not limited to, sponsorship at local, state, or national conferences.
9. Provides guidance and direction to chapter advisors/faculty relative to organization of new student chapters, integration of Student Merit Award Program into student chapter activities, and opportunities for incorporation of student and professional chapter goals.
